We are honoured to announce that the 2009 JKA International Training Camp (Gasshuku) will be held in Ottawa, Ontario from August 21-23, 2009. As part of the event, three of JKA's most senior instructors from the Honbu Dojo will, for the first time in history, offer training sessions in Canada.

Master Ueki, Master Tanaka, Master Osaka and Sensei Kobayashi will instruct five classes over the three-day camp, as well as oversee all levels of dan gradings and qualification exams for judge, instructor and examiner.

The JKA welcomes all of its brown belt and black belt members and affiliates to participate. Please inform all of your dojo members of this once in a lifetime opportunity. Mark off August 21-23, 2009 on your calendar and post the dates on your dojo website. This is one camp not to be missed.

Camp participants must register by June 30, 2009. But don't wait. Banquet seating is limited to 350 tickets so reserve your spot early. Note that camp participants must pay in US funds, and present their JKA passports on the first day of the event.

Also, all eligible participants are highly encouraged to take the qualifications exams to broaden their understanding of traditional karate. Attendance at all of the training sessions is mandatory for dan and qualification examinees.

 5. Dan examinations (1st Dan to 7th Dan)
- Only camp participants are eligible for examinations
 - Examinees must have a **JKA passport** with a copy of previous **Dan Exam certificate** as well as a copy of the **current qualification card**
 - Examinees who are transferring from another organization must inform registration representative prior to attending the camp
 - Examinees must meet the minimum time frame requirement between exams as stipulated by JKA HQ

- B) Fundamentals training seminar for 2nd and 3rd Dan
- C) General training seminar for Brown belts and 1st Dan
- D) General instruction for all

6 th Dan	Exceeding 5 years after 5 th Dan
7 th Dan	Exceeding 6 years after 6 th Dan, 50 years old and above

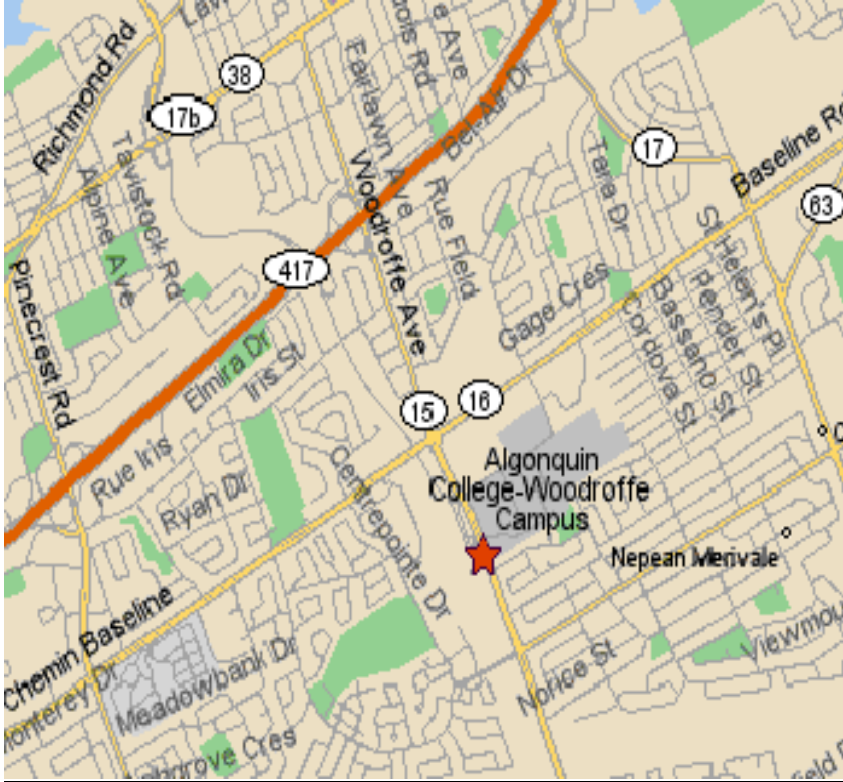

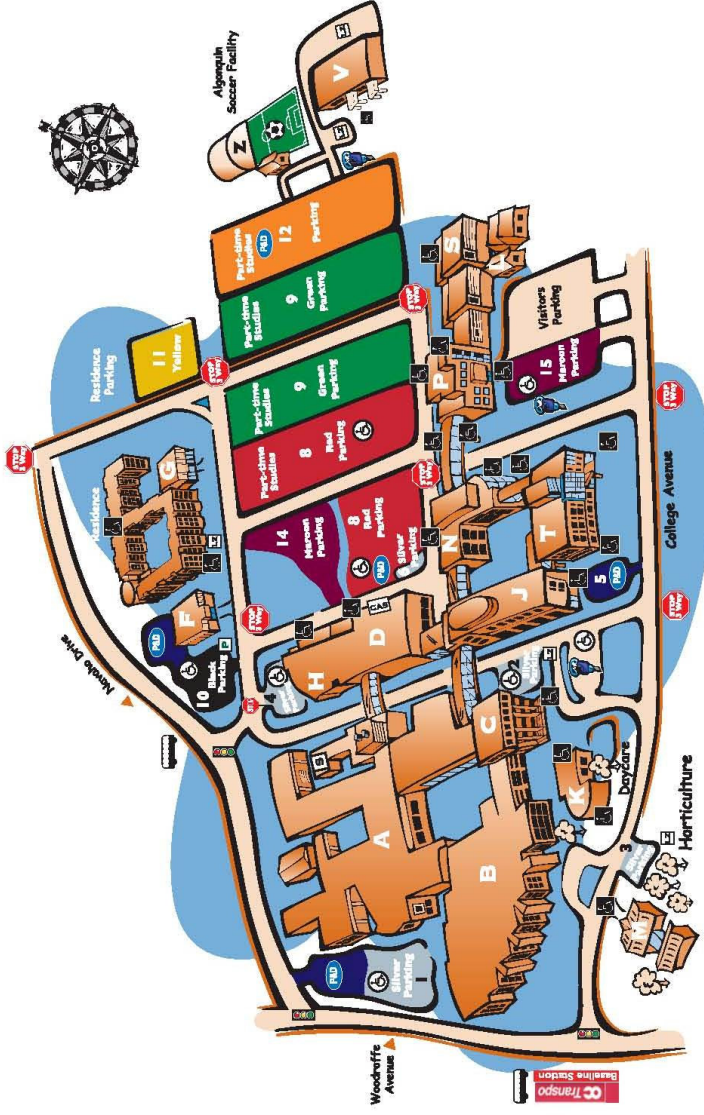
