1. INTERNATIONAL GASSHUKU, JKA SUDAMERICANA – August 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>



Led by Oishi T. Shihan, 9th Dan, Assistant Chief Instructor of JKA HQ, assisted by Hakizume K. Sensei, 3rd Dan, current JKA National Kata Champion in Japan and coordinated by Inoue M. Shihan, 8th Dan, President of the JKA Sudamericana, a massive technical seminar was held with the participation of more than 300 karatekas from all the countries of America.

The masterful practices taught by Oishi T. Shihan were focused on Kihon Kumite and Jiyu Kumite where he demonstrated the great technical skill that characterizes him and led him to be one of the most famous Kumite competitors in history. The second part of each of the practices was led by Hakiziume K. Sensei, with explanations and spectacular executions of the katas: Bassai Sho, Kanku Sho, Unsu and Wankan. In turn, Inoue M. Shihan was responsible for the translation and coordination of each of the practices and with his accurate explanations and demonstrations, he provided the possibility for all attendees to receive the instruction correctly.

A great honor for JKA Colombia to have been responsible for the organization of this momentous event.

The Children & Youth competition began with categories from 11 years to 20 years, Male and Female in the modalities of Individual Kata and Kumite. In the 15-16 year old categories, both Kata and Kumite team competitions were presented.

- Senior Competition, August 19th





In the Senior competition there were 5<sup>th</sup> age categories, 40-45 years, 46-50 years, 51-55 years, 56-60 and Over 61, Male and Female in the Kata and Kumite modalities.



- Adult Individual and Team Competition



Adult Category Competition, Male and Female from 21<sup>th</sup> years of age. He developed in the modalities of Kata and Kumite.
